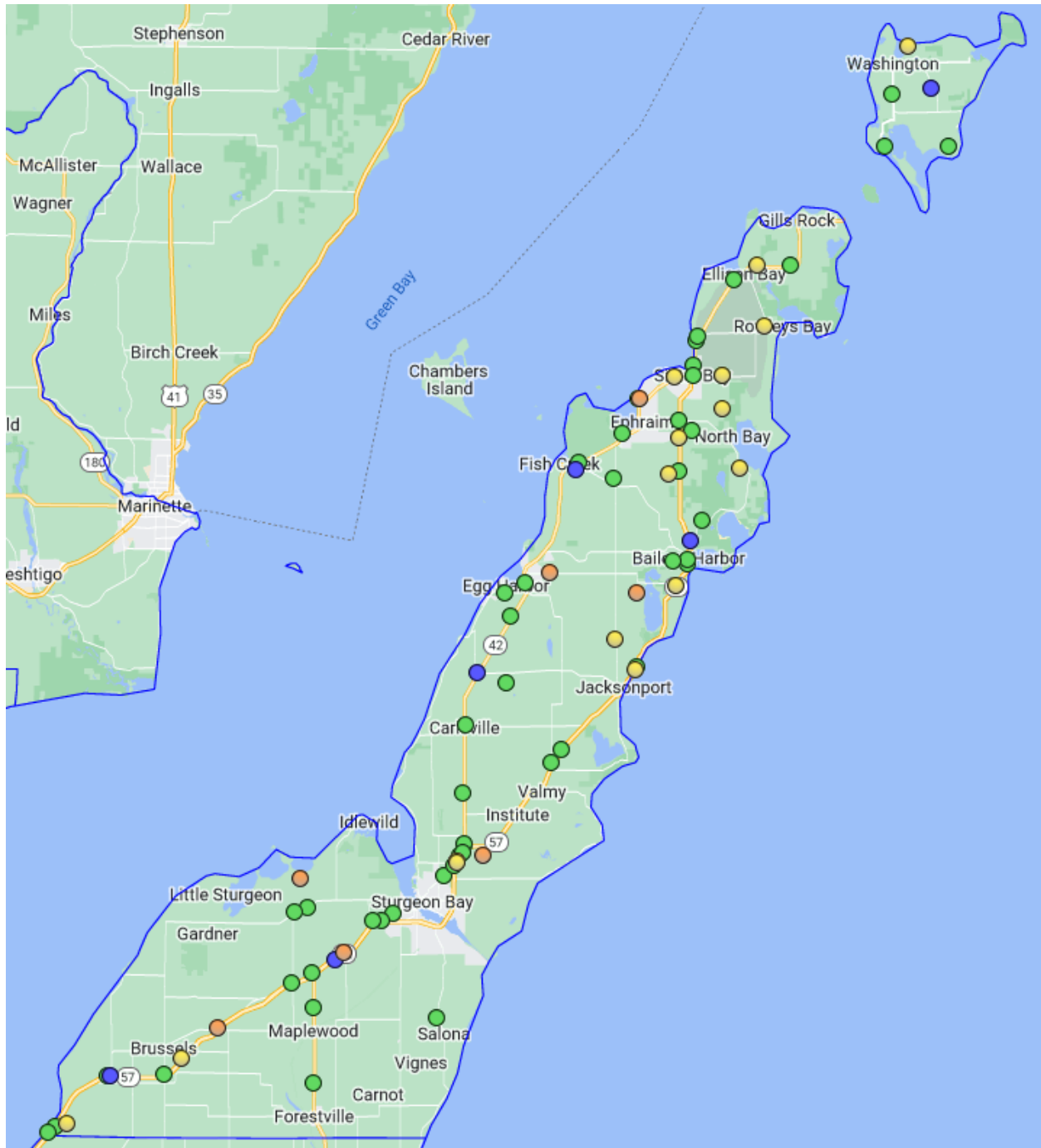
Minutes:

1. **Call to Order** – 9:00 a.m.
Chairman Roy Englebert called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
2. **Establish a quorum** – agency representatives in attendance: Roy Englebert, Thad Ash, Pat McCarty, Brad Shortreed, Jake Holtz, Aaron LeClair, Nathan Martin, Clint Henry, Chad Shefchik, David Englebert, Randy Asman, Jenny Austin and Randy Wiessinger..
3. **Adopt the agenda**
Motion by McCarty, seconded by LeClair, to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.
4. **Introduction of guests:** None.
5. **Public Participation**
Paul Anschutz (221 N. 6th Avenue, Sturgeon Bay), spoke re: the Gordon Road & STH 42-57 Intersection. He also requested information concerning the suggested truck route.
6. **Correspondence**
Commissioner Ash read a letter from Dan Woelfel, Town of Sevastopol Chairperson, re: need to improve the traffic flow at STH 42-57 and Gordon Road, noting a right turn lane is the only workable solution.
7. **Minutes of February 3, 2022, 1st Quarter meeting**
Motion by Shefchik, seconded by Englebert, to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2022, 1st quarter meeting. Motion carried.
8. **Pending, continued, "old" business**
 - A. Review Crash Data: Intersection of CTH H and STH 57
Randy Asman reported that the Safety Engineer submitted applications for J-Turns at both the CTH H and Stone Road intersections with STH 57. They will go through the normal approval process. Movements will be restricted at these intersections.
9. New Business
 - A. Safety Concerns: Intersection of STH 42-57 and CTH BB
Randy Asman reviewed slides showing the area and had a number of concerns and comments:
 - Crash patterns. This intersection doesn't have a crash record that would warrant a State safety improvement project. The crash rate is .42. When the rate approaches the neighborhood of 1, it is looked at for how to make it safer.
 - The current project planned for the area will be resurfacing with no changes.
 - Stop conditions: The DOT looks at conditions.
 - For LED Blinker Stop Signs, there must be at least 2 crashes due to failure to stop, and this intersection doesn't meet requirements.
 - For Flashing Beacons, we don't have enough history to show we have a problem.

Asman said they know there are concerns. The DOT has to look at the intersection and compare to its peers. It does not have a record that would warrant a safety improvement project.

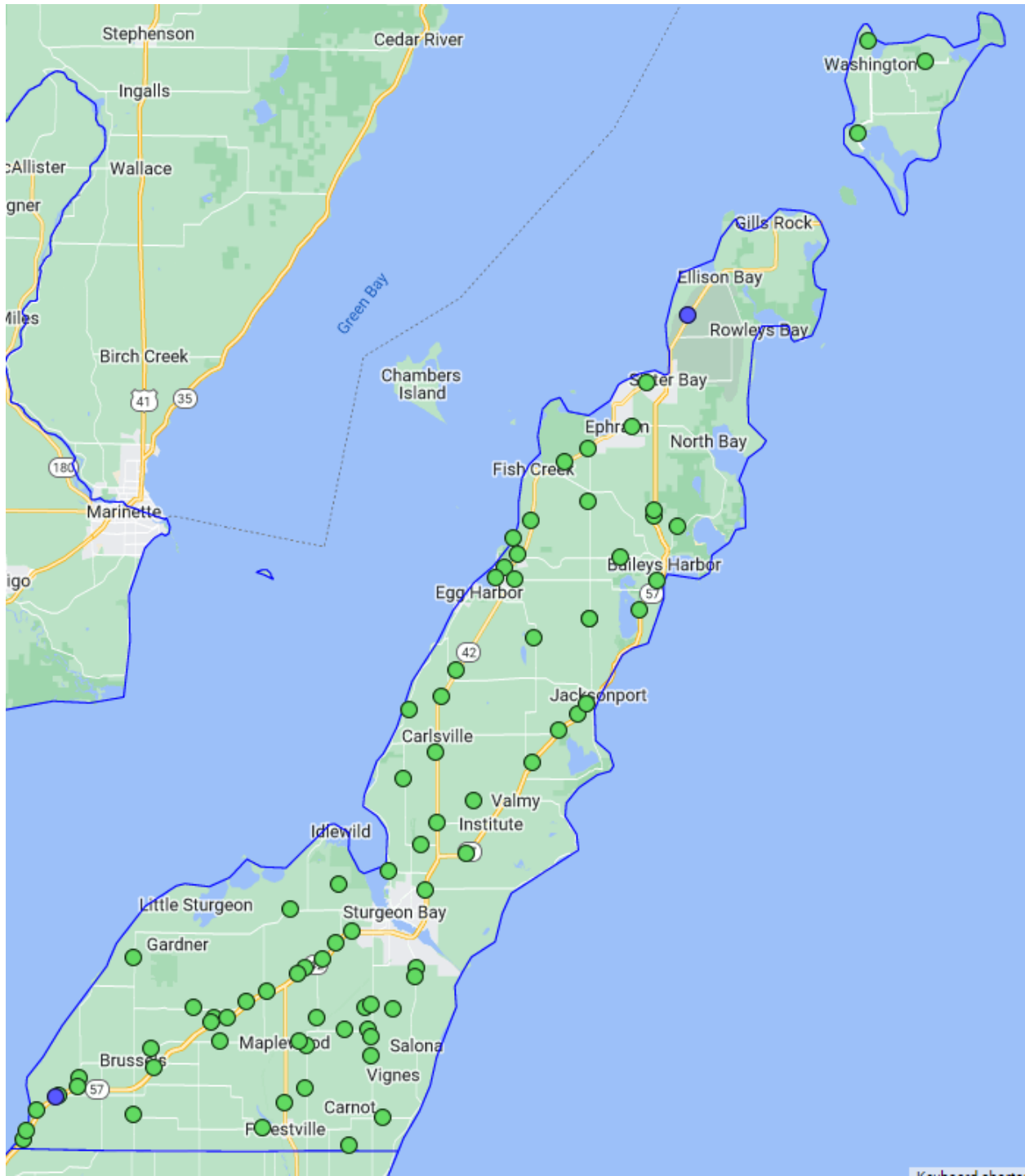
Highway Commissioner Ash is trying to apply for bipartisan infrastructure funds to have a right turn only at this intersection and a left-hand turn lane for those heading north. If accepted, it would probably be 2024-2027 for improvements.
10. **DOT Update**
Asman reported on the highway resurfacing project south of Bayview Bridge to South Junction. Resurfacing is scheduled to be completed by the end of June. The total project should be completed by the end of September.

11. **BOTS Update (Bureau of Transportation Safety)**
Wiessinger reported there have been 154 crashes in the county as of May 1st, with 39 injuries and no fatalities. Last year there were 91. The vast majority are speed related crashes.
Note: Wednesday, July 27 will be Speed Awareness Day.
12. **Review of 'Spot Maps'**
 - A. 1st Quarter 2022
The first quarter had a total of 81 crashes (0 fatalities, 26 injury), and 46 deer crashes.
13. **Review of Fatality Reports**
No fatalities in the first quarter of 2022
14. **COMMISSION REPRESENTATIVES CONCERNS: "For a Better & Safer Door County"**
 - A. Matters to be Placed on a Future Agenda or Referred to a Committee, Official or Employee
 - Shefchik commented on truck routes and said it was his understanding is that these are more of a recommendation for easier movement. There is no ordinance with restrictions, other than on Third Avenue. He said he can bring it up to Fincantieri.
 - D. Englebert said he'll be approaching the town board regarding the Pleasant Ridge intersection with CTH D, and issues with the hill and gravel trucks.
15. **ANNOUNCEMENTS**
 - McCarty reported on the County Deer Advisory Committee. Their hands are tied as to options to reduce the deer herd.
 - Trooper Austin said Landon Derginer will be a new Trooper in this area.
 - Discussion on driver behavior: Spread the word – be responsible for your own behavior.
