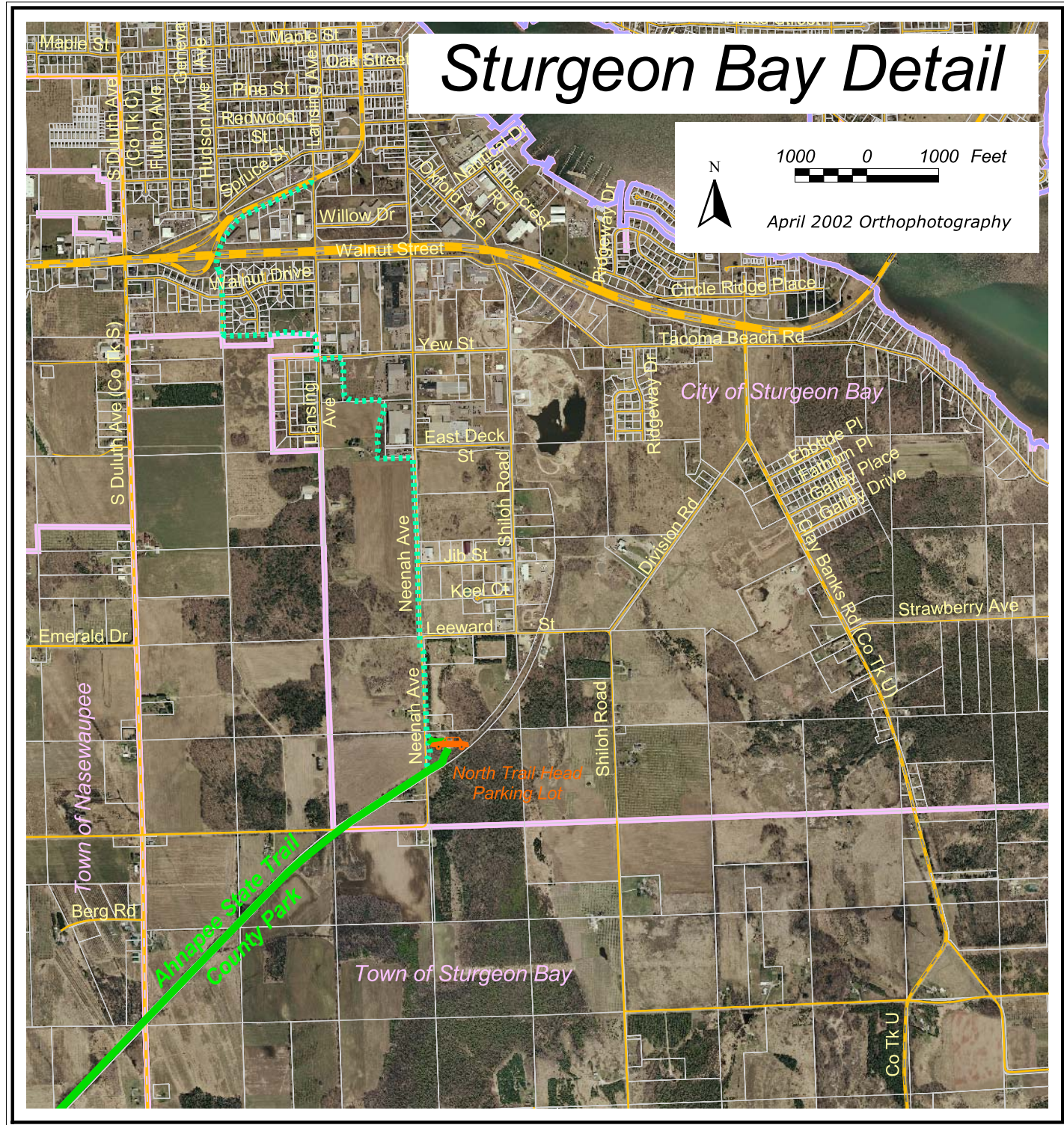




The Ahnapee State Trail spans about 30 miles between Casco, Algoma, Forestville and Sturgeon Bay. Sturgeon Bay is the Trail's northern most access point or resting stop. The City of Sturgeon Bay is a popular tourist destination, with many shops, restaurants, and lodging establishments to choose from. The Ahnapee State Trail is a multi-use trail, with an 8 to 10 foot wide surface comprised of packed limestone screenings. In the summer, people can walk, jog or run, ride bicycles, ride horses, or drive horse drawn buggies on the trail. In the winter snowmobiles and cross-country skiers share the trail.
